Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning (AIML)

1. Course duration and Class work:

- Duration of the Online Certificate Course is 6 months.
- This course consists of Three (3) theory and One (1) Project work.
- Each subject duration is **2 months/8 weeks.**
- No. of classes allotted for one subject is **24 classes/ 48 hours**.
- There will be **weekly 3 classes per subject** (generally alternative days in the week).
- Class Work Timings: 6:30 PM to 8:30PM The theory & practical sessions will be held through Online Mode.

2. About Credits:

- You will receive total **15 credits for this Certificate Course** (3 credits for Theory and 6 credits for Project).
- The credits allotted for each subject are equivalent to the credits of the individual subjects offered in B.Tech. as per JNTUH Academic Regulations-2022.
- The credits for the Project are not equivalent to the B.Tech. Major/ Mini Project of JNTUH Academic Regulations.
- The students of constituent and Affiliated Colleges (both Autonomous & non-Autonomous) can avail the **provision of transfer of credits** earned for the individual theory subjects offered as a part of Certificate Courses for the award of U.G. degree as per the provisions of B. Tech Academic Regulations-2022 of JNTUH.

3. Attendance for Theory/ Lab session:

- 75% attendance is compulsory for each Theory/ Lab session.
- Condonation of shortage of attendance upto 10% i. e. between 65 and 75% may be given by the Director, SCDE on genuine and valid grounds with supporting evidence and shortage of attendance below 65% shall in no case be condoned.
- The total no. of classes allotted for each subject are 24, the no. of absent classes should not exceed
 6 per subject. In case you were to do so, you need to get the permission from the Course coordinator to attend the upcoming classes.



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4. Evaluation Scheme:

a) Internal marks:

- Continuous evaluation through assignments with a weightage of 40%(Theory/Lab).
- Weekly assignments will be given (per **one** Subject total no. of *Assignments: 8*, each assignment

carry 5 internal marks, 8X5M=40 Marks).

• There will be no fixed pattern for the *Assignments*, it is purely based on the faculty's decision.

b) External marks:

In External examination, each subject in the course consists of two parts (Part A and Part B) for 60 marks and time duration of 3 hours.

Part A: Quiz type questions for **50 marks** (quiz paper consists of 50 Multiple Choice Questions and each question carry ONE (01) mark, total 50 marks).

Part B: Descriptive type questions for **10 marks** (descriptive paper shall contain 5 questions and each question carry TWO (02) marks, total 10 marks).

<u>**Completion of the certificate course requires successful completion of both assignment</u> component/ Lab record, External examination component for each Theory & Practical course in the online certificate course and Project work.

- (i) Continuous evaluation through assignment with a weightage of 40% (Theory / Lab).
- (ii) The end examination with a weightage of 60% (Theory / Lab).
- (iii) The requirement for passing (Theory / Lab) would be at least 40% in Continuous evaluation and 40% in the end examination with an overall average of 40% for a pass (Theory / Lab) in the course.
- (iv) [Internal marks per subject =40 and External marks per subject= 60; Total marks per subject= 100]

[Minimum Pass marks: Internal (16) + External (24) = Total (40)]

5. Project work:

- candidate must carry out a 4-week project work as partial fulfilment of the certificate course.
- Candidates are informed to submit the Project abstract on or before specified date.
- Candidates should meet their respective guides through online meeting for discussion and carrying out their project work.
- Candidates should submit the Final Project report (Soft Copy) on/before specified date to **scde@jntuh.ac.in.**
- Project will be evaluated in two stages.
 - In **stage-I**, the SCDE committee consisting of Director, Deputy Director, Project Supervisor and Senior faculty member shall evaluate the project work, where the candidate has to submit the abstract, platform, domain etc.



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- In **stage-II**, the external examiner shall evaluate the project work for Viva-Voce, where the candidate has to give the presentation along with demo/execution of the Project carried out.
- Grades will be awarded to indicate the performance of project work done by the candidate.
